

# **Water Rate Increase**

• Willows Water District Board of Directors adopted a water rate increase of 4.71% at its November Board meeting. The rate changes go into effect for water bills issued on or after January 1, 2024. The rate increase is needed to offset Denver Water's Master Meter rate increase of 5%. The increase covers the District's cost of purchasing water.

# **Capital Improvement Fee Increase**

• The Board of Directors adopted an increase of the Capital Improvement Fee of 1.0%, or an increase of \$0.40 cents per billing, per customer. The Capital Improvement Fee funds necessary infrastructure projects and maintenance that keeps our system operating efficiently and allows us to provide our customers with clean and reliable drinking water.
